Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Provide support and assistance to other skilled crafts working on project by performing the following duties:

- Clean work area, construction crew trucks, tools, and equipment
- Load and unload equipment and materials
- Use a hand shovel to dig around existing utility structures to prevent damage
- Prepare pipe and apply coating
- Operate air compressor, boring and pneumatic tools
- Set forms
- Perform all duties in a safe manner

- Basic understanding of Maintenance of Traffic (MOT)
- Basic math skills

Physical Demands and Work Environment

• Will be exposed to outside weather conditions, be prepared for extreme heat and cold
